National Finals for all categories will be held from July 31st to August 1st, 2026, in Airdrie Alberta, Canada. Caribbean Canada Pageants will crown the winners, who will then represent the Caribbean & Africa at the Ms. World Universal International pageant.

1. PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

The Ms Caribbean Canada Pageant is a platform dedicated to celebrating Caribbean and African culture, empowering women, and fostering confidence, leadership, and community involvement among participants across Canada. Contestants agree to participate with a positive attitude and openness to personal growth.

5. TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Participants must be natural-born females.
- Participants should be in good health.
- The participant must return the title, crown, and sash to CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. right away if she is discovered engaging in adult activities in the future. These activities include porn, nudity, illegal activity, and any other adult activity, both in the past and the present as well as during the competition. Additionally, without any objection or protest from the participants, CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. , the "Company," may take any legal action against any such activities carried out by entrants.
- Upon the occurrence of any of the conditions listed above, WINNERS, if chosen as Miss/Ms. CARIBBEAN or AFRICA CANADA, shall wear the crown for a period of one year, unless the next successor is chosen or unless the Company requests the return of the crown.
- Throughout the pageant, contestants are expected to act with professionalism and courtesy at all times.
- The winner will not be permitted to use the Miss/Ms. CARIBBEAN or AFRICA CANADA 2026 crown, title, and sash during any promotional activity other than CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC.
- Any participant, competitor, or winner may be disqualified at any time by the Organization. There are no guarantees that an international pageant will occur at any particular time. If the winner of the title of Miss/Ms. Caribbean or Africa Canada is unable to represent Canada at the International Pageant for any reason, the organization may direct the next winners to fill the winner's spot.
- If the National competition is cancelled by the organizer CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. the fee paid will be returned to the delegates. However, if the contestant's application is rejected, or she withdraws from the competition, or for any other reason, the fee that has already been paid by the contestant for the subsequent level will not be refundable under any circumstances.
- The Finalists for Miss, Ms. Caribbean or Africa Canada 2026 will be required to arrange for their own travel and accommodations (air tickets, road transport, hotel etc.) during the National pageant. Winners will need to arrange their own round trip air tickets for the International Pageant and any appearances they make as a winner.
- The participant must provide honest and precise information; any misleading or inaccurate information will not be taken into consideration. The CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. has the authority to hold over, cancel, or disqualify the applicant's application. In addition, the CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. has the authority to use necessary legal means to prosecute the applicants. Contestant accepts that CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. 's and the competition's judges' decisions are final.
- MISS/MS. CARIBBEAN or AFRICA CANADA and all the runners-up are required to be under the Company's contract for 1 year and are not permitted to start their own

pageant, either directly or through their spouses, families, or other loved ones, or to assist another pageant or system with recruitment for another pageant system, without the Company's prior written consent.

- The competition's/company's rules, guidelines, and code of conduct must be followed by contestants.
- Before or during the competition, a contestant is not permitted to converse with the judges. Contestants who are seen in any way attempting to approach a judge will be immediately disqualified. Judges may be present at the competition site, but they cannot be reached for private chats or by any other methods.
- The photos, videos, and other materials/details given by the participant may be used by CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. for promotional purposes in the future. The competitor shall never object to such a privilege or demand any payment or other form of compensation from CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC.
- Any financial loss, property damage, or personal harm sustained by a participant as a result of their participation in the competition and during company-hosted events will not be covered by CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. Participants in the competition do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- The company's rules and regulations are subject to modification as the company may deem necessary, with or without prior notice and/or notification to the contestants. All changes and modifications made by the company to these terms and conditions will be accepted and abided by all contestants both during and after the competition without any objection.
- The Organization is not liable for any injury, loss, or damage incurred during participation in the Event.

NOTE: CARIBBEAN CANADA PAGEANTS INC. will not disclose any personal information pertaining to the finalists, including but not limited to contact numbers, email addresses, dates of birth, biographies, or similar information, without the prior consent of the respective finalist.
